ATTENDANCE:

In the event of the student being late or absent from the Academy, the absence record must be filled in by the parent/guardian and sent upon the child's return to the Academy. We urge the parent to have all absence documented in the Academy handbook. The Academy does not encourage children to be taken early or brought late. In case it is unavoidable, the parent must send a note to the class teacher. While taking a child early, the parent must meet the PRO first and sign the register.

COMMUNICATION:

Since the handbook and the calendar are prepared at the beginning of the year, minor changes in the date and timings may sometimes have to be effected. This will be communicated through the handbook. Please acknowledge receipt of all notes and communication received through the handbook. In the event of a strike or an unexpected holiday during an examination, the new date of that day's examination will be notified later and the rest of the examinations will continue as per the schedule.

DISCIPLINE CASE:

The Academy reserves the right to expel any student whose conduct is harmful to the Academy atmosphere. Immorality, Insubordination or contempt of authority and breaking rules are some of the reasons for immediate expulsion or rustication. It is mandatory for the parents/guardian to come and collect such children from the Academy.



SCHOOL BUS RULES

Discipline must be maintained in the bus at all times. Pupils must accept the authority of the driver and the staff. If you repeatedly break the rules then you may be debarred from using the Academy Transport.

The following instructions must be observed:

- Sit down on the seat allotted to you.
- Do not walk around in the moving bus.
- Do not fight with other students.
- Do not throw or litter things in or out of the bus
- Do not damage the interiors of the bus.
Any damage caused by you will be charged.
- Speak softly as shouting may distract the driver.
- If you need to get down at a different stop, then you need to bring a written request from your parents/guardians and get the approval from the Academy Office.

Pointed shoes will NOT be permitted.

- Boys must come clean shaven and properly groomed.
- Costly jewellery will not be permitted on campus.

Entering the class with a smile and spreading this smile among the students is the best technique for class - room management.

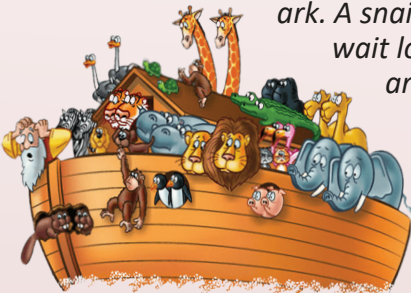

Understanding their needs with love and care will help us to keep that smile on us always. For this smile, the children would go out of their way to do their best as desired by us.

REMEDIAL CLASSES

- 10-12 % of children struggle with learning and have difficulty in school work.
- Scholastic backwardness can be due to various reasons including learning disabilities.
- Does your child have difficulty in reading, writing, spelling, following instructions, and mathematics in spite of giving them sufficient training?
- Remedial education, special classes and individualized training will be given to children with reading, writing, spelling, mathematical difficulties.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO GUARDIANS

- The Academy emphasizes a high standard of discipline. This calls for co - operation from parents. It requires their honouring the Academy rules and regulations themselves as well as seeing that their wards also do the same.
- Punctuality is essential at all times. Students must reach their classrooms at the allotted time. Students who contravene this rule without valid reason must meet the PRO first before proceeding to the classrooms. On the fourth occasion they will be sent home.
- Parents may meet teachers from 8:45am to 9:00 am / 3:00 to 3:45 pm on all working days.
- Parents are not allowed to enter classrooms either to see their children or the teachers.
- Parents are requested to co - operate with the Academy in its attempt to help their children's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and discipline and by taking interest in their children's work. They should check the handbook every day and note the homework and any other instructions, if given. They are advised to check their child's school bag, to see if any notice, invitation, etc. has been issued.
- They are requested to inform the Academy if there is any change in their address or telephone number.
- Leave for half day should be avoided as far as possible. In an emergency, written permission must be taken from the Principal & the class teacher.
- Children, when sick, must not be sent to the Academy to attend classes.
- The child's name, class, section and the bus no. (If applicable) must be clearly mentioned in the handbook.
- Kindly check the uniform, nails and hair of your child every morning. They should be immaculately turned out daily.
- Please ensure that your child carries text / exercise books according to the time table only. No extra books are allowed. We do not want our children to be burdened by a heavy school bag.

For any act of serious indiscipline, the academy reserves its right to expel the student with or without warning.

There must be a name tag on each of your child's belongings. Expensive articles and jewellery are not allowed in the Academy. In violation of this rule, the article may be confiscated. The Academy bears no responsibility for articles lost in the Academy.

Use of scooters / motorbikes is strictly prohibited on campus. Violation of this rule may lead to suspension.

Any act or omission which may harm the atmosphere of the Academy or affect its image will be treated as serious indiscipline.

CONTRABAND ITEMS:

Cameras, mobile phones, chewing gums, electronics and costly items are strictly prohibited in the Academy premises. Such things will be confiscated from the student and in addition, the students will be suitably penalized. Books, other than the text books or library books, should not be brought to the Academy. The items confiscated will not be returned to the parents or to the students.

HEALTH AND HYGIENE:

Parents are requested to inform the Academy, if the child is not well. In the event of contagious diseases, parents are advised to keep the child at home. The cafeteria provides lunch facility not only for the boarding students but also for the day students. Lunch coupons may be purchased from the Academy Office.

Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian menus are provided.

REPORT CARDS AND BOOK SALES

(END OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR)

The REPORT CARDS will be given to the parents during the OPEN HOUSE that has been scheduled for each class. Textbooks will be sold on the very same day.

Parents must:

Collect the report from the class teacher. Class teachers will be in the Academy Auditorium.

Pay the first term fees after showing your child's report card at the cash counter.

After paying the first term fees, you may purchase the textbooks and notebooks.

Regular and college-size notebooks and book covers may be purchased from our bookstore.

EVALUATION TEST AND INTERVIEWS

The Evaluation Tests and Interviews for the new academic year for those students who have filled out the application forms and paid the registration fee will be conducted on the spot. Results will be published on the same day. Admission of new students will be provisional till we receive all the necessary documents.

VISITING BOARDERS

Parents / Legal guardians of resident students may visit their children only on the fourth Saturday and Sunday of the month between 2:00pm-4:00 pm. Report to the PRO first.

STUDENTS WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal of students during the academy year is not generally allowed. However, if a student is to be withdrawn for reasons beyond control, the fees for the whole year must be paid. This is applicable for withdrawal from the boarding and for late admission also.
